Senior Race Bosun

We are looking for dynamic, organized, and knowledgeable individuals with good communication skills and a passion for the sport of sailing to run weekly club sailing program races for 2017. Ideally the individual will have experience at the Sail Canada Race Management Level I/II (Assistant or Course Race Officer).

Reporting to the Head Race Bosun, this is a part-time position (weeknights and some weekends) from May to October with some scheduling flexibility. Salary is hourly and commensurate with applicable experience and certifications.

Primary Responsibilities:

The NSC Race Bosun team is responsible for the overall management and quality of weeknight club sail racing and weekend events. As either Principal Race Officers or Mark Setters on-the-water, Senior Race Bosun duties include:

- Assist the Head Race Bosun in managing equipment, scheduling, and overseeing the development and direction of Junior Race Bosuns.
- In the absence of the Head Race Bosun, act as the Principal Race Officer in overseeing the professional management and execution of scheduled races.
- Coordinate member RC volunteers and apply NSC's club RC Volunteer system.
- To professionally run fair and enjoyable competitive races in accordance with the Sailing Instructions, Racing Rules of Sailing, and NSC Bosun Guidelines.
- Ensure that club RC boats and gear are properly equipped and maintained.
- Operate boats and oversee volunteer safety using common sense and training.
- Perform other general Bosun duties as directed.

- Pleasure Craft Operator Card (PCOC)
- VHF Radio operator's certificate
- Current Standard First Aid and CPR-C
- Sail Canada Race Officer Level 1 (ARO)
- Previous experience as a Race Course Officer

- Sail Canada Silver VI or CANSail 5
- Lifesaving Society Boat Rescue Course
- Sail Canada Race Officer Level 2 (CRO)
- NSC Scoring or Race Management Seminar
