



Our Sailing School is currently seeking an Assistant Sailing School Instructor to assist our Head Instructor in 2017.

The Ideal Candidate should have:

- Appropriate sailing experience and have completed Can Sail 1 & 2 instructor certification
- Sail Canada instructor registration – 2017
- Current Pleasure Craft operators card

We offer:

- Competitive compensation
- Excellent teaching room facilities, with white board, table and chairs
- Free on site parking, plus access to day lockers

Our program:

- Teaching Can Sail #1 and #2 to Adults, including appropriate text books
- Training courses are offered on Monday and Wednesday evenings between 6.00 and 9.00 pm and Tuesday and Thursday evenings between 6.00 and 9.00 pm starting in May and ending in August
- We have a fleet of nine CL – 14s and two 420s, plus a new 14 foot Brig with a Mercury 40 HP, which is used as a Safety/Rescue boat, and a 10 foot Zodiac with a 10 HP motor for the use of the instructors
- Sailing club members assist with in-boat supervision as required, and with sailboat setup, maintenance and repairs

- General direction and advice are provided by an experienced Sailing School Director and by the Rear Commodore – Boating
- We operate as part of Ontario Sailing/ Shells & Sails program “Get out on the water – 2017”
- We also offer opportunities to participate as crew members in the club’s informal Friday evening races and after-race barbecues
- On successful completion of the sailing school training, graduates are offered, for a nominal fee, trial membership in the club and access the use of the school sailboats for the balance of the membership year
