

2011 ISAF World Championships

Location: Perth, AUS

Dates: Dec 3-18, 2011



Overview:

The Canadian Yachting Association is responsible for entry of all athletes for this event.

ISAF selection criteria:

Fleet Racing:

Each MNA (i.e. CYA) is entitled to **one entry per event**.

Quotas:

Additional Entries:

Additional entries must be applied for by the MNA between January 1st, 2011 and June 30, 2011.

- 10% of the Event Quota is reserved for the ISAF Qualification commission
- No MNA shall have more than 6 entries, unless entries remain after June 30, 2011, entries available at this time will be awarded by the Qualification commission.
- 90% of MNAs with a second entry in the 2010 Qualification Events get a second entry in order of finish
- 70% of MNAs with a third entry in the 2010 Qualification Event get a third entry in order of finish
- 50% of MNAs with a fourth entry in the 2010 Qualification Event get a fourth entry in order of finish
- 30% of MNAs with a fifth entry in the 2010 Qualification Event get a fifth entry in order of finish
- 20% of MNAs with a sixth entry in the 2010 Qualification Event get a sixth entry in order of finish
- MNAs with more than one individual in the top 150 of the ISAF World Rankings (June 30, 2011) are eligible for additional entries. MNAs will be awarded an additional entry in order of 2011 ISAF Rankings for every individual in the top 150 other than those individuals for whom the MNA received an entry based on the 2010 Qualification Event, until either the MNA maximum (6) is reached or the Class Quota is filled. Any remaining entries that are not awarded under this section will be delegated to the Qualification Commission to award.

CYA Selection of Athletes for Fleet Racing Events:

- 1) Athletes placing in the top 16 and top ½ of 2010 World Championships (excluding Star and 49er classes) will be allocated first available berths, nominated in top finishing order
- 2) For Star and 49er only, athletes placing in the top 16 and top ½ at the 2010 Skandia Sail for Gold event, Weymouth, GBR – August 10-15, 2010, will be allocated first available berths, nominated in top finishing order
- 3) Any remaining berths will be allocated based on athlete finish position at the 2011 Skandia Sail for Gold event – Weymouth, GBR – June 5-11, 2011.
- 4) If any berths remain, they will be allocated based on athlete finish position at the 2011 Miami Olympic Classes Regatta.

Match Racing:

Each MNA is entitled to one entry. If more than the 32 Quota entries are applied for the field may be expanded to a maximum of 40 entries.

- The number of additional entries will be determined by July 1, 2011
- No MNA will have more than 2 entries
- Additional entries must be applied for by MNA prior to June 30th, 2011
- 2nd entry will be determined based on MNAs with two or more teams on ISAF ranking list as of June 30, 2011
- MNAs will be ranked in priority order based on their second placed team on ISAF Women's Match Race ranking list.

CYA Selection of Athletes for Women's Match Racing:

Athletes will be selected based on the outcome of a domestic trials event schedule for September 2011 in a location to be confirmed. (Toronto/Kingston)

Amendment - Applicability of Olympic Trials Criteria:

Selection for the 2011 ISAF Worlds plays a role in the selection of the 2012 Canadian Olympic Sailing Team. In recognition of that role, sections 8, 9, 10, 12, 13, and 14 of the document “Canadian Olympic Trials for Sailing at the 2012 Olympic Games” will apply to the selection events for the 2011 ISAF Worlds described above.
