Sail Able Association of Nova Scotia's aim is to promote the integration of persons with disabilities into the sport of sailing for competition and leisure. Currently we own/operate two accessible sailboats (Martin 16's) and are located at the Royal Nova Scotia Yacht Squadron.

We are seeking two CanSail 1 & 2 Instructor Certified sailing instructors to assist with the promotion and development of our program and organization. This individual will be responsible for the following duties:

- providing both on and off the water sailing instruction to our members
- operating and maintaining our fleet of sailboats
- launching and retrieving sailboats as required
- assisting sailors on and off our sailboats
- arranging bookings for persons who wish to go sailing
- assist with Learn-to Race program and attend regattas

Our sailing program will run from mid June to late August and instructors will be employed for 35 hours per week offering a flexible schedule for our disabled sailors. Instructors must be willing to work on weekends. Instructors will be paid \$15 per hour. Individuals must be attending or returning to a post-secondary institution in September to be eligible to apply.
