You will spend the majority of your time actually SAILING with people, rather than being in a motorized coach boat. We work mostly one on one with people with various challenges including visual impairments and other physical challenges as well as some cognitive challenges. We offer our sailors instruction, companionship and racing opportunities. Our program utilizes a fleet of 3 Martin 16 sailboats, a Hobie trimaran and a 23' Sonar sailboat as well a motorized coach boat.
