



CANSail Advanced Instructor – Project Leader

Sail Canada's CANSail Dinghy program is delivered at clubs & schools across the country, by Trained & Certified Instructors. The programming is designed to get, and keep, sailors excited about sailing for life! The six CANSail levels promote progressive training of core dinghy sailing skills.

The CANSail Instructor Pathway is being revised to include an Advanced Instructor Clinic. The Advanced Clinic will aim to provide high-level training to instructors who have completed the first level of instructor training and have experience delivering the CANSail Program. The Advanced Clinic will be designed to encourage on going development and foster continued learning for instructors delivering CANSail programs.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Develop content, materials, assessment & evaluation tools for CANSail Advanced Instructor Clinic, including:
 - Curriculum & Clinic schedule
 - Instructor Candidate Manual & Resources
 - Learning Facilitator Resources & lesson plans
 - Candidate assignments
 - Candidate Assessment & Evaluation tools
 - Compile resource lists, video links, professional development opportunities, etc...
- Consult with Technical Experts (Learning Facilitators, CANSail Panel, Subject Matter Experts) engaged in CANSail Instructor training & CANSail program delivery
- Incorporate NCCP requirements & content with sailing technical content

Skills Required:

- Ability to work independently, seeking guidance and input when needed
- Strong understanding of the CANSail program, NCCP & Canadian Sport System
- Technical sailing background and experience delivering instructor &/or coach training programs preferred
- Strong communicator, available to consult with volunteers on evenings and weekends as needed
- Proven ability to produce written content
- Confident working in Microsoft Office programs, knowledge of Adobe InDesign an asset
