Club Judge Sample Test Questions

15 Questions – Test is 50 Questions.

Answer each question by writing T (=true) or F (=false) after it. Applicable rule numbers can be added in the last column.

1.	A party to a protest hearing may be disqualified even if she was not the boat protested.		
2.	Photographs and videotapes cannot be admitted as evidence in a protest hearing.		
3.	Any witness other than a member of the protest committee must be excluded from the protest hearing except when giving evidence.		
4.	The time limit for requests for redress is the same as the protest time limit.		
5.	When a protest committee finds in a technical committee protest that the deviations from the class rules were caused by damage and did not improve the boat's performance, it cannot penalize her.		
6.	After reaching a decision, the protest committee must promptly inform the parties to the hearing of the facts found, conclusions, rules that apply and the decision.		
7.	In an appeal, unless the national authority decides that the finding of facts is inadequate, it must accept the protest committee's facts found.		
8.	At the conclusion of a hearing, a written copy of the protest with the decision must always be given to a boat disqualified.		
9.	The rules state that all people, including witnesses, have a right to be present throughout the hearing.		
10.	A competitor in a race may not normally serve as a protest committee that will hear a protest in the same race.		
11.	A party must not read a protest before the protest's validity has been established.		
12.	A race committee that protests a boat because of an incident it saw on the water is not required to inform the boat after the race as long as the protest committee posts a notice of the time and place of the hearing.		
13.	During a hearing the protest committee can penalize a third boat that is not a party to that hearing.		
14.	A protest committee member who was also a witness in a protest hearing may not participate in the decision on that protest.		
15.	The protest committee shall hear all protests that have been delivered to the race office unless it approves a protestor's request to withdraw the protest.
