Sail Canada is pleased to be working with the [Respect Group](#) to provide the **Respect in Sport - Activity Leader** training program to all Sail Canada instructors/ coaches, officials and anyone who actively works in the youth sailing environment.

What is it?

A 2.5 hour online training program, designed to educate coaches/leaders on the important issues associated to bullying, abuse, harassment, and discrimination. The program deals with numerous issues which are relevant to anyone in a coaching &/or leadership role in our sport.

RESPECT IN SPORT FOR ACTIVITY LEADERS AND COACHES offers an engaging and easy to use internet-based training course for sport leaders of all levels. The intent of this training is to:

- Empower and educate youth leaders/coaches on the prevention of abuse, bullying and harassment.
- Build a holistic culture of respect within the sport community.
- Provide fundamental training tools which enable ALL coaches and youth leaders to become even better role models for the young athletes in their care.

The Coaching Association of Canada is using the Respect in Sport online training in conjunction with the Responsible Coaching Movement to increase coach education and keep sport safe for everyone involved.

Take the training now!

Completing the Respect in Sport online training is easy, simply sign into your [Sail Canada Profile](#), click on [Respect in Sport](#) and you will be taken to the Respect in Sport program to set up your profile.

Track your training

The program is linked to the Sail Canada database. Completion of the program will be shown on your Sail Canada profile. When you complete the program, there is also an option to upload the certificate directly to the CAC Locker. The Respect in Sport - Activity Leader training program counts for 3 NCCP Maintenance of Certification points. We encourage everyone who has already completed the program to upload their certificate to the Locker (through your Respect in Sport profile).

Completing training through another organization

Anyone who has already completed the Respect in Sport Activity Leader training or chooses to complete the training through another organization (a provincial organization, another sport, etc...) can submit their certificate of completion to Sail Canada (instructor@sailing.ca) to have it added to their Sail Canada profile.

Cost

The cost of the training is \$30/user. The program is set up as a user-pay model however should any clubs/provinces wish to pay on behalf of their coaches, it can be arranged by contacting the Respect Group.
