Responsibilities:

The successful candidate will be responsible for the following:

- Traveling through Alberta with the Mobile Sailing School Program (MOSS) as part of the Alberta Sailing Association's outreach program to deliver sailing programs.
- Ensuring a safe and positive environment for all participants
- Careful use and maintenance of sailing equipment, vehicle and trailer
- Work with on-site volunteers

- Be able to work as part of a team
- Be well organized and have the ability to effectively manage time and priorities
- Be outgoing and positive
- Have excellent communication skills and keep accurate records

Qualifications:

- Current CANSail 1&2 Instructor or higher
- Current Emergency First Aid or higher
- Coach Boat Safety
- Class 5 Driver's License with clean driving record
- Pleasure Craft Operator Card
- The successful candidate will be required to obtain a Criminal Background check
