- Strong sail programming, leadership, and organisational skills
- Current First Aid, CPR certification & Boat Safety certification
- Enjoy working with children and youth, and previous experience working in a camp setting is an asset
- Police Check and Vulnerable Sector Screening (we can assist with this)
- Hold a valid Toronto Harbour Licence and Pleasure Craft Operators Card (we can assist with this)
- Keelboat, racing and regatta experience are assets
- International candidates must have, or be in the process of gaining, a valid Canadian work permit
