The ideal number of participants for the seminar is 10, to allow reasonable engagement and interaction. A second course will be delivered to accommodate more participants. To maximize the effort put into preparing for the course, the second course will be scheduled shortly after the first. After some discussion, it was agreed that the participants would be split into groups based on experience. The Club Judge Seminar has good interest, with participants from 3 provinces registered to date. There is no overlap in attendees between the two courses. 4.2 On-line Testing The Club Judge test is set up in ClassMarker for use as part of the online CJ seminar. Katie Nicoll has set it up and tested it. It seems to work well and provides what is needed for this test. The platform is free to a certain point; further use seems to be reasonably priced. There is agreement that using the same platform for all testing would be best. Using ClassMarker for the Regional/National test would be the best option to remain consistent for the delivery of these courses.
