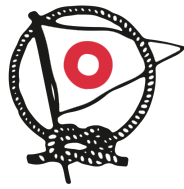
Positions available for CANSail 5/6 Laser, 420 and Opti Race Coaches

The coach will demonstrate professionalism and courteous behaviour during all interactions, with students, student parents, members, and colleagues alike. The adherence to safety protocols is essential, as the safety of our participants and staff is a top priority at TS&CC.

Responsibilities

The successful candidate will report to the Head Instructor and be responsible for the following activities:

- Coach a fleet of 420, Laser and/or Opti youth sailors.
- Provide a safe, fun and educational environment to participants.
- Prepare for lessons and deliver the Sail Canada curriculum such that the students learn boat handling, learn sailing theory, earn Sail Canada levels and achieve success on the race course.
- Play a role in ensuring club equipment and facilities remain clean, tidy and in good repair throughout the season.
- Maintain records of student achievements, attendance and related job activities.
- Work productively with other staff to deliver high quality programs.
- Attend all scheduled staff training events and meetings.
- Attain, maintain and upgrade required certifications and qualifications.
- Core season runs from the last week of June to the end of August.
- Occasional weekend work will be required to coach and coordinate students participating in regattas.

The ideal candidate will possess the following qualifications and/or be working toward attaining them in the near term:

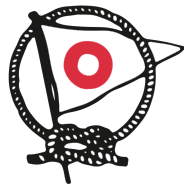
- Current CANSail 5/6 Instructor Training or Certification or CANSail 3/4 Certification with a lot of racing experience.
