

## Sailing Instructor position

Sail St Andrews, based in St Andrews, NB, is looking for a qualified sailing instructor for the 2021 season, from June to the end of August, full-time. Salary and accommodation allowance will be discussed.

The successful candidate will be responsible for teaching basic sailing skills to youth 9 years and up (and possibly a few adults), on Mirror dinghy class sailboats and a Paceship 20, and do the following:

- Prepare lesson plans for basic, and more advanced courses.
- Assist in getting boats ready by performing light maintenance on them.
- Teach each class of 8 students with the help of the teaching assistant.
- Monitor students' progress, and perform evaluations.
- Follow and teach safety skills, both on land and on the water, including Covid rules.
- Keep all equipment in proper order.

For this job, the candidate requires the following qualifications:

- Sail Canada Instructor certification, or willing to get it completed
- Valid Boat Operator Card, or willing to get it completed
- Basic First Aid and CPR certificate, or willing to get it completed
- Experience teaching or leading youth groups
- Experience operating a motorized dinghy
- Criminal Record check done in the last 12 months
- Valid driver's license
- Have great communication, leadership and organization skills
