4.0	Work Plan	4.1 On-line Learning – review & poll Provincial hosting and reporting needs must be kept in mind when planning training. Courses and training targeting the club level should be run by PSA's (in conjunction with Sail Canada). Provincial funding models are built on provincial delivery and reporting of training. Regional and National level training and course delivery is the responsibility of Sail Canada. There has been good feedback and participation in Practice Protest Hearings over 5 sessions. Leaders felt that some of the participants needed more guidance to get through the protests smoothly. A poll or survey for feedback from participants would provide more direct feedback and be helpful in planning future sessions. Action: Develop a poll to solicit feedback on the online training opportunities delivered this season. 4.2 On-line Schedule Kathy Dyer is preparing to deliver a session on the new rules. An Advanced Seminar will need to be planned for next year based on demand. Consider timing and schedules. 4.3 Hearing procedures and social distancing There are some regattas happening, including a few upcoming in BC. Hosts have been prepared to have hearings in outdoor areas if needed,	

		but they have largely not been needed to his point by using appendix U. Virtual hearings are also taking place.	
		World Sailing will be adding items to Sailing Instructions under 'Rules' using [DP] – protocols related to COVID-19 may be issued at any time and will state if they are a rule.	
		This item will be tabled for now, but considered further as the situation with COVID continues to develop.	
		4.4 Officials sub-committees & newsletter There was discussion amongst the officials' sub-committee chairs about a Sail Canada Officials Newsletter with content from each of the officials' areas. This would allow for wider dissemination of information across the officials groups.
