3.0	Courses & Training	Bast and West versions of the course slides have been successfully merged into one updated presentation deck for each course. The courses have now been delivered in Ontario a few times and courses are coming up in Manitoba and Quebec. Some suggested changes have been noted. The work group will meet again after spring courses are complete to share feedback and adjust the courses as needed.  It was noted that translation of the slides is taking place now. It would be helpful to track which slides or sections are updated so that the French versions can be more easily updated.  There is agreement that there is a need for a stand-alone RRO course. This course would focus and test primarily on technical skills. The NRO course would be a combination of technical skills and leadership/judgement ability.  3.2 ARO/CRO Course Online Delivery  In between meetings a request came in and the Chair approved that the CRO course could be delivered entirely online as a trial based on COVID restrictions in place in most provinces. The committee was consulted via email and agreed with this decision when discussed at this meeting.  Ontario Sailing will be trialing the practical component in a virtual setting next week. All members of the committee are invited to observe one of these sessions if they'd like. Login information will be shared.	

		3.3 Future Online Seminar & Webinars  Based on COVID restrictions, it appears that there will be limited racing again this season in most parts of the country. Some suggested webinars include:  - Interacting with Coaches - Interacting with Athletes - Running races for Boards & kites - Running Good Dinghy Races - The OA & RC – Working together - Scoring  There was agreement from the committee to focus on these for the fall/winter, suspecting that many are feeling Zoom fatigue and trying to get outdoors while the weather is nice.	
5.0	Program Criteria & Forms	4.1 Changes to NRO Criteria & Assessment Rob Woodbury will continue to work on edits to this document in preparation for use in the fall. It is expected that there will be relatively few applications for new certification in 2021, based on COVID.  Consideration needs to be given to adjusting the criteria and requirements for certification based on COVID limitations, to allow individuals to progress through the program.  One suggestion is to adjust the experience requirement for RRO, with the introduction of an RRO course, to make it more accessible to developing RO's. The NRO requirements should remain the same. A shortened first period of certification may be considered during first year of RRO certification.  Action item: Begin to work on development of the RRO course in preparation for delivery in the fall of 2021. This falls in line with their recent experience working on the ARO/CRO course.  It is noted that some people feel the points-based criteria is confusing and challenging to navigate. This is something to be looked at and perhaps simplified. There is agreement that this is an opportunity to relook at all the criteria.  4.2 Application Form Update The updated application form and checklist have been set up as fillable PDF's as a test. They work but may not be the best option. There is a desire from the Sail Canada Office to try moving to an online form in place of PDF's. The committee is supportive of this, with an emphasis on making it simple and easy to both access and complete.
