ILCA (Laser) Race Coach

The Race Sailing Coach will be responsible for the FBYC Laser Sailing Team. They will be responsible for planning and running practice for the athletes 5 days a week during the summer and if possible, on weekends during the spring and fall seasons. The coach will also be required to attend and coach at all regattas. Good organizational and communication skills are required. They will be in contact with parents, other teams, and regatta coordinators and therefore must be friendly, courteous, and knowledgeable of the rules and regulations.

Among the most important qualities we look for in our instructors and coaches is the ability to instill a love and joy for sailing in those you are teaching and coaching

Responsibilities

- The sailing coach must be able to teach safety, boat handling and sailing theory to students in ILCA dinghies who are intermediate or advanced racing sailors.
- They must be able to develop and follow lesson plans that include dry land and on-the-water drills and inclement weather activities.
- They must assist in the revision and implementation of the performance racing curriculums and program material.
- Communicate effectively with a wide range of people associated with the programs, including but not limited to participants, parents, volunteers, and other staff
- Perform daily opening and closing duties, maintenance and cleanliness of sailboat fleet, coach boat fleet, coaching equipment, and instructional spaces
- Maintain an enthusiastic attitude and a desire to help shape a small, friendly, fun-filled sailing school.

Regattas

- They will assist Sailing School Director in regatta registration and planning.
- They will assist parents with planning process- reminders, directions, details of regatta, etc.
- They will possess a willingness to travel to out-of-town regattas
