

RACE MANAGEMENT MASTER COURSE CONDUCTOR (RMMCC)

Effective February 1, 2023

Description

- A Sail Canada Race Management Master Course Conductor (RMMCC) is the highest of two levels of Sail Canada certification for race management instructors.
- A Race Management Master Course Conductor (RMMCC) is a National Race Officer (NRO) or higher who has been trained to present courses given by an RMCC (ARO, CRO, AML, ML) and the Sail Canada Advanced Race Management Course. The Advanced Course is for those seeking certification as Regional Race Officer (RRO) or National Race Officer (NRO).
- Certification is valid for four years. See RMSC Policy 1.

Required Skills

- Teaching is first and foremost communication. A candidate for RMMCC will demonstrate clear, simple and effective delivery of course content. This includes suitable preparation of all documentation and audio-visual content.
- Good race management requires knowledge and practical application of group management, race procedures and racing rules. A candidate for RMMCC will demonstrate a high level of knowledge, practical experience and skill in effective race management.
- People vary in learning style and areas of interest in race management. A candidate for RMMCC should be a good listener and demonstrate the ability to adapt presentation and explanations to suit the situation. It's important to provide feedback that is positive, specific and informative so that successful candidates leave enthusiastic about race management.

Requirements

- Current certification as a certified NRO or higher.
- Minimum of two years' experience as a RMMCC.
- Abide by the Sail Canada Code of Conduct.
- Successful participation as a trainee instructor at a Sail Canada Advanced Race Management Course.
- Successfully organizing and conducting one Sail Canada Advanced Race Management Courses under the supervision of a currently certified RMMCC.



Certification Process

- Certification as Sail Canada RMMCC is managed by Sail Canada Race Management Sub-Committee (RMSC).

Using the online or paper application form, be prepared to submit the following information:

- Event log listing all courses delivered during the preceding four-year period, including names, current email addresses of the Course chairperson and/or Host Official and the supervising RMMCC.
- Certification requires a signed copy of the Race Officials Code of Conduct (an Appendix of the Sail Canada Code of Conduct).

Recertification Process

- Recertification as Sail Canada RMMCC is managed by Sail Canada Race Management Sub-Committee (RMSC).

Using the online or paper application form, be prepared to submit the following information:

- Evidence of an applicant having participated in a minimum of one Advanced Race Management Courses per certification period.
- Certification requires a signed copy of the Race Officials Code of Conduct (an Appendix of the Sail Canada Code of Conduct).

What is the next level?

In Canada, the highest level for race management instructing is the Race Management Master Course Conductor (RMMCC). To become a World Sailing International Race Officer (IRO) seminar instructor, you must first be certified as an IRO.
