- Develop Yearly Training Plans with sailors (where appropriate)
- Communicate training plans, schedules, etc. with parents and guardians
- Assist with travel logistics and transport
- Travel to regattas with the team
 - This role requires domestic and international travel (dependent on schedule)
- Report to RNSYS Sailing Director

Qualifications

- Minimum of three years of coaching experience
- Minimum of CANSail 5/6 coaching qualification or equivalent certification from an internationally recognized authority
- Sail Canada Competition Development (Level 3) coaching qualification, Sail Canada Learning Facilitator qualification, or equivalent is considered an asset.
- Experience coaching at national & international level regattas is considered an asset.

Terms of Employment

- Term: April 1 October 31
- Hours: Weekly hours will vary depending on team and additional job requirements, both part-time and full-time contracts will be available
- Compensation: Commensurate with experience and qualifications
- Reimbursement of Sail Canada Instructor Dues and of pre-approved regatta expenses at the discretion of the RNSYS Sailing Director
