- Skill and experience relating to and communicating with parents and other volunteers.
- Evening & Weekend work maybe required.
- Knowledge of and ability to perform required role in emergency situations.
- Prompt communication with members and other program participants.
- Communicate with HOS and Program Manager as needed
- Support in the completion of progress reports on each student in the lesson program at season's end.
- Performs other appropriate tasks assigned by the HOS and Program Manager.

- Current CANSail 1 & 2 and/or 3 & 4 Instructor
- Current Standard First Aid & CPR certification
- Pleasure Craft Operators Card
- National Lifeguard Certification preferred but not required
- CPR, First Aid, and other relevant certifications (or willingness to obtain).

Physical Demands and Work Environment

- Must often work in a warm and humid or cool and breezy outdoor environment.
- Ability to bend, stretch, twist or reach, walk, stand, stoop, climb stairs, balance and/or crouch.
- Continuous repetitive motions.
- Physical exertion over long periods of time.
- Work in hot and humid environment.
