

WHAT IS THE UNIVERSAL CODE OF CONDUCT TO PREVENT & ADDRESS MALTREATMENT IN SPORT (UCCMS)?

The UCCMS is an overarching code of conduct that provides a strategy to prevent and address maltreatment across all levels of sport systems and for all participants in sport.

WHAT IS INCLUDED IN A BREACH OF THE UCCMS?

Prohibited behaviors under the UCCMS include but are not limited to maltreatment. Maltreatment is a deliberate act, which results in harm or the potential for physical or psychological harm, whether it is intended or not.

FORMS OF MALTREATMENT

- PSYCHOLOGICAL
 - Verbal or non-physical.
- PHYSICAL
 - Contact and non-contact.
- SEXUAL
 - Online, verbal, social media etc
- NEGLECT
 - Lack of reasonable care.
- RELATED TO REPORTING
 - Ex. Failure to report
- GROOMING
 - Process of building trust and comfort
- RELATED TO PROCESS
 - Ex. falsifying information
